
Monitoring The Internationally Prohibited Weapons' Airstrikes In Syria (1\6\2016 - 15\8\2016)



About The Internationally Prohibited Weapons



White Phosphorous bombs:

it is a firebombs cause deep burns from second and third degree. it sticks to the body and causes (death) because entering the phosphorus into the body. Human rights watch considered using of this bomb is equal to use of the internationally prohibited cluster bombs



Chlorine gas:

It is a chemical weapon that high concentrations breathing leads to lack of oxygen, flow secretions from the nose, burns in the cornea and irritation of the mucous membranes and can lead to cardiac arrest. The agreement of the chemical weapons prohibited using of chlorine gas from the first use in 1993

Cluster bombs:

shells falling from the air or fired from the land, designed to open in air throwing their content from sub munitions which maybe cover very big areas (about areas of several football fields). Oslo declaration was signed to make an agreement in February 2007.
